About Love Your Block

Love Your Block brings mayors together with citizens to revitalize their neighborhoods, one block at a time. From painting over graffiti with colorful murals to banishing trash from playgrounds, citizen volunteers are combating urban blight and making their blocks better places to live.

For its 2018 City Hall AmeriCorps VISTA Love Your Block program, Cities of Service awarded each winning city \$25,000 to be used for mini-grants and resources to support the efforts of citizen groups and local nonprofits to fight property blight through home repairs, lot transformations, and community cleanups. In addition, two AmeriCorps VISTA members serve in each winning city's city hall to build capacity and raise awareness. The program is made possible with support from Bloomberg Philanthropies and the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS).

Position Overview

Cities of Service is seeking an [AmeriCorps VISTA Leader](#) to be based out of our New York City office. The VISTA Leader will offer coaching, professional development and technical assistance to a cohort of 20 AmeriCorps VISTA members and report to a Cities of Service program manager.

VISTA Leader responsibilities include:

- Conduct regular check-in calls with each VISTA member
- Participate in check-in calls with grantee city leads
- Foster a community of practice among VISTA members by hosting webinars, developing resources, managing VISTA Slack workspace, group calls, and periodic in-person engagements



- Provide project management support around metrics collection, reporting, and planning to grantee cities
- Manage VISTA administrative record keeping, including PTO, monthly reports, call notes, and other items as needed
- Share VISTA members' work with a broader audience through a monthly newsletter, written reports, and other mediums
- Provide tools, techniques, and guidance to enhance VISTA project stability and sustainability
- Support recruitment and orientation of highly qualified VISTAs as needed
- Make recommendations to improve the existing Love Your Block program systems and processes

Cities of Service Love Your Block AmeriCorps VISTA Leader's term of service begins on **September 3, 2019**. The VISTA Leader will support two AmeriCorps VISTAs in each of the following cities:

Duration and Compensation

This is a one-year, full-time AmeriCorps VISTA commitment commencing on September 3, 2019. A living stipend is provided and an additional end-of-service award is provided contingent on successful completion of the service year. Relocation assistance is provided if needed.

- Must have completed at least 1 year of full-time service prior (AmeriCorps or Peace Corps)
- Some college preferred
- Experience working in community engagement preferred
